Meeting Minutes –November 20, 2019

I. Call to Order

Steve Blair called to order the regular meeting of the Mount Holly Springs Planning Commission at 7:00 p.m. on November 20, 2019 at the Borough Office.

Pam Still motioned to accept the minutes from the October 16, 2019 meeting. David toner seconded the motion. The minutes were approved as submitted.

There has been no further information on this plan. Borough Council had previously approved the request for an extension until April 14, 2020. The last planning meeting before that is March 18, 2020.
