

Mt. Holly Springs Planning Commission

Meeting Minutes – February 19, 2020

I. Call to Order

Steve Blair called to order the regular meeting of the Mount Holly Springs Planning Commission at 7:00 p.m. on February 19, 2020 at the Borough Office.
